County eyes regional partnership membership

Strathmore Standard — Wheatland County is looking at joining other municipalities around Calgary in the Calgary Regional Partnership initiative. County councillors heard a presentation CRP administrator Rick Butler and others at their June 23 municipal planning commission meeting. County Manager Jennifer Deak said some of the issues presented were development of regional emergency response, watershed information management data base, waste management and recycling, transportation data base and economic development. Wheatland County has approved a letter of intent to join the CRP. In her letter to Butler, Deak said Wheatland County “certainly recognizes that many of the issues facing local municipalities are shared issues and best addressed collaboratively with our neighbours.” She said the promotion and fostering of creative approaches to planning and resolving issues by using the resources of the region can only prove mutually benefiting for all involved parties and the communities “we serve.” The application has to be approved by the CRP executive committee. The Town of Strathmore is a member of the partnership as well.
