Calgary Regional Partnership receives increased Alberta government grant

Strathmore Standard — The chair of the Calgary Regional Partnership (CRP) is pleased the provincial government is increasing its financial support.

A new working relationship between CRP and Alberta Economic Development increases annual funding from \$60,000 to \$100,000.

"We are delighted to receive this funding from government to work on a seamless regional economic development framework, the development of a comprehensive business development strategy, and a number of regional prosperity projects," said CRP Chair Linda Bruce during the group's spring general assembly May 26 in Priddis.

"When we work together to attract investment and develop the region, we strengthen our economy and improve the lives of Albertans."

The grant supports CRP's 2006-07 economic development operational plan that is focused on several key strategies including a strategic assessment, opportunity identification and marketing, regional planning issues including transportation, emergency response, water, waste management and a First Nations protocol.

Rob Renner, Alberta Municipal Affairs minister, made the announcement during the assembly on behalf of Alberta Economic Development Minister Clint Dunford.

This new agreement not only increases government financial support but also increases flexibility by increasing the length of the term from three to five years. The Calgary Regional Partnership comprises 19 member communities representing over one million Albertans.

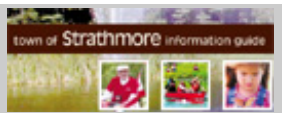

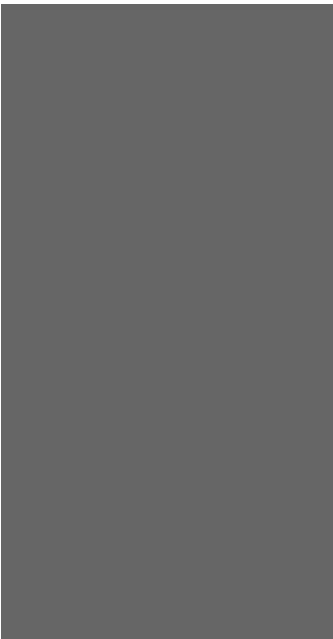
